#### **Finance Area**

The mission of the Finance program is to provide business students with the financial management and analytical skills to become successful managers and leaders in a technology oriented global environment. The Finance program curriculum is designed to provide students with tools required for careers in financial management in corporations, financial services industry, and not-for-profit organizations. The courses offered emphasize empirical application and managerial decision-making in all areas of finance including insurance and real estate. The concentration in Finance, Finance and Financial Planning Dual Concentration, and Accounting and Finance Dual Concentration are designed to equip students with the breadth of knowledge required to become effective financial analysts, financial planners, and financial managers in a rapidly changing global, economic, and technological environment.

A minimum grade of "C" is required in all Business Core Courses, courses taken in the concentration, and CMAT 109 College Algebra for Bus & Econ, CMAT 110 Calculus for Bus & Econ, CENG 105 College Composition I, and CENG 106 College Composition II.
